

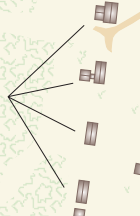

Richard Bennehan started Stagville Plantation in the 1780s. When Bennehan's daughter Rebecca married Duncan Cameron, the two men became business partners.

The plantation holdings of the Bennehan-Cameron families were among the largest in antebellum North Carolina, and among the largest of the entire South. By 1860, the family owned almost 30,000 acres of land and nearly 900 slaves.
